### **Summary of Rules**

- All games played according to rules of the FIBA as modified by Basketball Ontario.
- Games consist of (four) 8-minute quarters, stop time.
- 4-minute overtime period(s), if needed.
- Standard 15-foot free-throw line.
- 2 free throws starting on the fifth team foul in each quarter
- 2 sixty (60) second time outs in the first half and  
3 sixty (60) second time outs in the second half  
1 sixty (60) second time out per overtime period.  
Time outs do not carry forward
- Three-point shot in effect where there are three-point lines.
- Basketball Ontario tie-break format used in the event of a tie in pool play, and to determine wildcard teams in the Bantam/Major Bantam A section.

## Atom

- Each team must have a minimum of 10 players to play a game.
- The game will consist of four quarters of play. Each quarter will be divided into two (2) periods of four (4) minutes each resulting in eight (8) periods of play.
- Players Equal Participation Rule in effect. This rule will be in effect for the first seven periods. Each eligible player must play the minimum number of shifts as required by Basketball Ontario.
- During the first seven (7) periods, substitution will occur only at the end of each period.
- The time between period four (4) and five (5) is halftime. The shifts immediately before and immediately following half time are not considered to be back-to-back in the U11 Atom/ U12 Major Atom level of play because of the half time break. Free substitutions may occur at half time. This rule is contingent upon equal participation conditions being met for all team members.
- Substitutions are permitted for medical reasons at any time and if an injury occurs during the first seven (7) periods.
- Final period of play. Open substitution will only be permitted in the final four minute period of the game or any overtime periods.
- The throw-in shall be from the out-of-bounds at the division line in the backcourt opposite the scorer and timer's table.
- Only person-to-person defence permitted (no zones). Each player on the defensive team must guard a player on the opposing team, but does not need to closely guard a player outside the three-point line (or where it would be marked). A person with the ball may be double-teamed.
- **No full-court pressing permitted (per EOBA rules).**

## Major Bantam

- Person-to-person and zone defences and presses are permitted.
- 20-point drop-back rule.
