



## **Barrhaven Girls Basketball Association Bursary Award Criteria**

Barrhaven Girls Basketball Association (BGBA) Bursary Awards (\$500.00) are awarded annually to 2 BGBA players (one from the competitive program and one from the recreational program) who are under the age of 21, and have applied to attend the first year in a post secondary institution in the fall. The award recipients are chosen on merits relating to their academic standing, contributions to the community, and their involvement with BGBA.

Applicants are asked to provide details of their basketball career and accomplishments, involvement in community and school activities, academic standing, how they personally benefited from their basketball experience, and their career plans.

Application submission deadline: **May 1**

### **BURSARY REQUIREMENTS**

To be considered for a bursary, the following are required:

- You must be a currently registered player of the BGBA and have been for a minimum of the last 3 years.
- You must be under the age of 21.
- You must be registered to attend a post-secondary institution on a full time basis for upcoming academic year.
- You must complete the application in your own words, using this template.
- You must provide at least one letter of reference from a coach, teacher or community leader that speaks to your involvement with BGBA, the community and your school.
- Your bursary application, including letter of reference, must be received by May 1.

Bursary recipients are required to provide proof that they are attending a post-secondary institution on a full time basis prior to receiving their funds.

Applicants may only apply once for a bursary.

The information you provide will be treated as confidential, and will be shared in committee only to the extent necessary for the association to come to a decision of who will receive the awards. The rationale for the selection of bursary recipients is confidential and decisions by the awards committee are final.
